Enter results from a maximum of three (3) competitions. Skating events considered are Freestyle (includes long program), Short Program, Compulsory, Artistic, Dance, and Pairs. At least one of these results must be from a Freestyle event. Enter actual points earned for each competition. If the number of skaters in the event was less than seven, you may start with seven to calculate actual points earned. There is a maximum of ten (10) points per competition. (attach copies of final result sheets that are for consideration) Competition points considered for the 2008 ice show will be those accrued beginning January 1, 2007, through December 31, 2007.
