COMPETITIONS

Only U.S. Figure Skating sanctioned competitions will be considered for point accumulation. You must have represented BMVFSC at the competition. Only one (1) event result sheet per competition is allowed. Enter results from a maximum of three (3) competitions. Skating events considered are Freestyle (includes long program), Short Program, Compulsory, Artistic, Dance, and Pairs. At least one of these results must be from a Freestyle event. Enter actual points earned for each competition. If the number of skaters in the event was less than seven, you may start with seven to calculate actual points earned (attach copies of final result sheets that are for consideration).

- Skaters competing on the Free Skate/Competition Track using the 6.0 system shall receive an additional five (5) points per final competition result sheet submitted. (*Copy of entry form must be submitted to document FreeSkate Track event).
- Those skaters competing on the Free Skate/Competition Track using the IJS System shall receive ten (10) additional points per final competition result sheet submitted.
- Skaters competing in a qualifying freestyle event at Midwesterns and/or Nationals will receive an additional ten (10) points per competition.
- Skaters competing in a qualifying freestyle event at Upper Great Lakes Regional competition will receive an additional five (5) points per competition

Competition points considered for the 2010 ice show will be those accrued beginning Winter Contract 2008, through the end of the Fall Contract 2009.
